Reinstatement Application Instructions

1. Fill in your complete information—including middle name or initial—company and contact info.
2. Attach copies of the Certificates of Completion *for each course* you are submitting. List the total number of Certificates of Completion you are enclosing with your application along with the grand total of credits listed on those certificates.
3. Enclose a \$100.00 payment for the Reinstatement Application fee; make it payable to *UGA-Master Timber Harvester*. Send it to us with your form and certificates to the address in the bottom left corner of the Reinstatement Application form.

ADDITIONAL REINSTATEMENT GUIDANCE

Continuing Education Requirements: Applicants must account for *all* past due continuing education requirements *as if their designation had not expired or been cancelled*. Refer to chart to determine your hours.:

For Reinstatements Filed December 2019 thru November 2020

If you expired on this date...	...you owe these continuing education hours:
2019	8 total credits (with 2 in Category A or Environment)
2018	16 total credits (with 5 in Category A or Environment)
2017 and earlier	Retake <i>MTH Intro Workshop</i> (enroll at gamth.org)

- CLE and CFE credits are equally acceptable for your GA-MTH Reinstatement Application. The *GA-MTH* office approves CLE credits. The *Society of American Foresters* approves CFE credits.
- Category credit hours are listed on your Certificates of Completion. Environmental credit hours under the old CLE rating system are counted as category A hours under the new system. All CFE credit hours are counted as category B CLE credit hours.
- No other professional accreditations (including ISA, GSWCC, etc.) will be accepted in lieu of approved CFE or CLE credits.
- If you are unclear about reinstatement requirements for your specific circumstances, we encourage you to contact our office.

Reinstatement Period: Continuing education credits cannot be applied towards more than one renewal or reinstatement period; we require the next additional hourly tier for reinstatements submitted after October.

Course Certificates or Contact Hour Notices: If a course was approved for CLE or CFE credit, the education provider was directed to provide you with a standardized Certificate of Completion, which bears the CLE or CFE logo and lists course information with approved credit hours. You are required to include this documentation with your Reinstatement Application.

Audit: Approved Reinstatement Applications will be randomly selected to confirm satisfactory completion of continuing education claimed. For this reason, we recommend that you keep original documentation for at least two years for any completed training you claimed on your Reinstatement Application.
